



Enrollment Assessment Options

Select eQUIP Academy Services courses are available with one or more of the following assessment options. If a course does have an available option listed below, you will be able to select it from the drop down box.

Diagnostic: First time the student clicks on the course it opens this dynamic diagnostic test to show mastery based on specific course standards. Depending on how well the students do, they could test out of some lessons that they already have mastered the content.

- Each lesson has roughly 3 questions that the students will have to master in order to test out of the lesson.
 - If the student gets the first question correct, they will be given question 2.
 - If they get the first question wrong, they are moved on to the next lesson to see if they can master that lesson.
 - If they get question 2 correct, they will be given question 3 for that lesson.
 - If they get question 2 incorrect, they will be moved to the next lesson and not exempted from the content.
 - If question 3 is answered correctly, they are exempted from the lesson.
- Test questions are pulled from a random bank that is not filtered out based on lesson mastery.
 - Students could have questions on a test from a lesson they were exempted from.
 - Due to them showing mastery, they should be able to answer those questions correctly.

Progress Test: The first time a student clicks on the course they are given a pretest to assess their learning level before any exposure to the content. Once they complete the last assignment of the course the student will be prompted to take the second or final posttest.

End of Course: This would be an additional “final exam” type of a test per part. The student is prompted to complete this test once they have completed the last assignment in the course.
