


Local Program Login Area

Taking every opportunity to promote the value of your program is vitally important. Students log into their courses frequently, most daily. Each login is your chance to connect with your students. With your program's login embedded within your website, you can post important messages and resources that will be viewed by your students every time they login. Posting your site's login page URL (web address) in all literature, in other areas of your school's website and social media helps communicate the existence of your program within your community. Placing the login on your webpage involves copying the login box code into the code of your page.

Instructions:

- Choose the webpage where you wish to show your program's login box.
- Ensure you or your network administrator has editing privileges for the page.
- Login into your website's admin portal or use web editing software to access your webpage's editable files.
- Navigate to the toolset that allows you to edit the webpage.
- Locate where you wish to place the login box. Below is an example of the login box.

- Paste the following code into the proper location.

- Save the page and test the functionality of your page.
